

ISO 14064 Carbon & ISO 50001 Energy Audits 1-day Training

"With End of Course Examination"

The United Nation Climate Change Committee (UNCCC) meeting was recently held in Paris with 170+ world leaders attended. President Obama & President Xi have announced that USA and China will respectively reduce their greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions in the forthcoming years in order to secure the temperature rise globally less than 1.5 degree Celsius in next two decades. It is imminent now not to exploiting the normal life of our next generation, all human beings living in this globe should work hand in hand to mitigate and alleviate the GHG emissions and the corresponding carbon footprint. Life cycle analysis (LCA) is adopted to estimate the GHG emissions. The methodology is stated in the **ISO14064**.

Reduction of energy consumption in the forms of fossil fuel, gas and electricity are being implemented in various countries over the world. It will be replaced by renewable energy such as wind, solar, and hydro, etc. Indeed, the management system required to alleviating the consumption of and to conserve the energy is stated in the **ISO50001**. The HKSAR Housing Authority requires all contractors in Hong Kong who are serving them to achieve this certification in a next couple of years. In addition, the HKSAR EMSD enacted a regulatory requirement for the energy audits of buildings in Hong Kong with a view to mitigating the energy consumption.
